*All assignments/check ins will be done over the phone once required paperwork is turned in.

*You are required to complete each assignment within one week after being assigned.

*You will be required to take before and after pictures of each assignment you are given.

DRESS CODE:

- Boots or tennis shoes that cover the entire foot are required. No slip-on shoes, high heels, slippers or sandals.
- T-shirts must have sleeves that reach the mid-arm, round collars, and mid-hip in length. No tank tops, muscle shirts, jerseys, shirts with obscene or derogatory pictures or phrases or advertising of tobacco and alcohol products.
- Pants must extend over the top of the shoe and must be worn with a belt or must fit tight enough around the waist that they do not droop past the top of the hips. No shorts, sweat suits, wind pants, warm-up pants or dresses.
- Caps/hats may not have obscene or derogatory pictures or phrases on them. They may not be worn backwards or sideways.
- You **MUST** wear the provided reflective vest at all times while working.
- Participants who are not appropriately dressed will not be allowed to complete their assignments and will be subject to reappearance before the Judge. The dress code helps us to ensure your safety.

VOLUNTEER RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT:

- I understand the above dress code rules and requirements, and will comply with them.
- I understand that my community service may start immediately; that I am responsible for transportation to and from the specified work site and to provide my own care while I am performing work. (food, water, etc.)
- I understand that I am responsible for any property loaned to me for use in my community service. I agree to pay for the replacement cost of any lost or stolen property in my care.
- I understand that any absence, failure to perform work as instructed, insubordination, intoxication, or illegal drug use will result in me being immediately dismissed and the reason for dismissal reported to the sentencing Judge.
- I will in no way consider myself or hold myself out as an employee of the agency involved in this program or of the City of Price, the Courts, the institution where I am performing this community service, or any other agency, business or individual as a result of this community service; nor will I make any claim for wages, unemployment benefits or worker's compensation benefits from any sources mentioned above as a result of this activity or community service.
- I will assume all liability for bodily or personal injury that I may receive arising from, and by reason of, any and all known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen causes, or any other consequences that may result from my community service tasks. I hereby release and hold harmless Price City and each and every municipality, agency, office, institution and/or individuals associated therewith where community service hours are performed for any injury to my person or property.
- If I do not successfully complete all of the hours of community service work that I have been ordered to do, **PRIOR TO MY RESET DATE**, I understand that I may be held in contempt of court, and shall be subject to reappearance before the Judge.

I, the undersigned, being of lawful age, hereby state to all parties concerned that "I have read the above provisions, understand them, and agree that these provisions shall apply to me."
